Tasting Notes:

Colour: Deep blackish purple with a crimson hue.

Bouquet: Ripe aromas of blackcurrant and black Cherie fruit with mocha oak tones underneath intermix with cedary tobacco dominate the nose over some spice and black olive.

Palate: Full bodied, richly flavoured Cabernet Sauvignon with vibrant ripe blackcurrant, cherry and plum flavours complexed by spicy mocha oak notes. Smooth, fine chalky tannins add to the layered finish.

Food: Succulent roast lamb shoulder with roasted vegetables, beef stir fry with fresh pickled ginger or sticky BBQ beef ribs.

Yield: 3 tonnes per acre

Harvest: March 2015

Remembered as one of the shortest and fastest. The 2015 vintage had near perfect conditions throughout. Mild ripening conditions, with below average temperatures set up the perfect ripening. A great vintage was capped off by above average grape yields and high quality fruit. Delicate flavours with great fine acidity in the Cabernet, while the Shiraz has full ripeness and deep intense colours balanced by really good natural acidity.
