Description:

The colour in this Shiraz is dark and rich with a garnet hue. The bouquet is ripe and lifted with dark plums, hints of caraway seed, spice and cedar. The traditional method of open fermentation has allowed the palate to be bold yet balanced with flavours of dark chocolate, black cherries, plum, sage and will balanced subtle oak. The tannins are soft, complex and lingering on the finish.

Winemaker's notes:

The 2016 vintage was a text book season with a long ripening period allowing the grape phenolics and flavour to ripen symbiotically with the sugar maturity. Once in the winery every care was taken during ferment to give the wine maximum time on skins to extract the depth of flavour and colour that this wine exhibits. This is a fantastic example of a well grown and well-made Barossa Valley Shiraz that is ready to drink now and will also continue to reward the patient for the next 15+ years

Serving hints:

Serve at room temperature with rib eye steak, grilled lamb or braised Kangaroo tail. Also great with a hearty beef stew.
